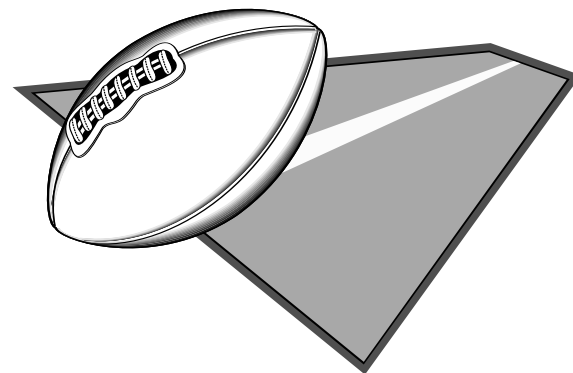

Advantages of the Camp

The purpose of this non-contact football school (no helmets/pads will be used) is to provide expert instruction in an enjoyable and informal environment. The school is open to all students who will be entering grades 4 to 10 this fall. Lectures, film sessions, demonstrations, drills, and learning competitions will be held daily under the guidance of Coach Gallagher and the Football School staff. Specialized instruction is offered for all offensive and defensive positions. There will be special emphasis placed on the Wing-T offensive system used by many high schools and colleges around the country (including Souderton Area High School). Each participant will have the opportunity to choose the position they wish to learn. Groups will be divided into a Sophomore Division (grades 4-5), a Junior Division (grades 6-7), and a Senior Division (grades 8-10).

The rules of the school are simple:

Rule #1 - Having fun is mandatory

Rule #2 - Learning is mandatory

Camp Director

Ed Gallagher is the head coach at Souderton Area High School. He won over 100 games as an assistant coach/offensive coordinator during his 13 years at Allentown Central Catholic High School & Pennridge High School. He was the coach for the 1993 PIAA 3A State Champions, two Suburban One League Liberty Division Champions, and the 2001 Suburban One League Colonial Division Co-Champions. After graduating from Gettysburg College (1990) where he was a Wing-T fullback for 4 years, Coach Gallagher has been running the Wing-T offensive system for 13 years before coming to Souderton. In 2006, he led Souderton to a first round PIAA Playoff victory. His record since 2004 is 39-14. He was named The Reporter 2004 Coach of the Year. In 2007, he guided the Indians to a league Championship.

Coaching Assistants

Bill Coddington - Freshman football coach at SAHS. He has been a high school football coach for 17 years at Souderton and North Penn. Mr. Coddington played College Football at Holy Cross.

Dave Allem - Freshman football coach at SAHS

Current and recently graduated football players from local high schools and colleges will work at the football school and assist the coaches by demonstrating drills and techniques to the participants.
