- Completing a 20-hour mentorship <u>All directions and steps to complete a mentorship are on Pathway Manager under the mentorship tab.</u>
- Attending one of more career expo's.(Remember, you must register to attend.)
- Continuing to explore electives and courses that focus on your strengths
- Attending Pathway trips
- Joining a club or activity

## In PathwayManager:

- Be sure to upload your last required reflection.
- Take a few minutes to read the directions on how to submit your Mentorship. You will need to send in a proposal, complete a signed contract and upload a mentorship reflection (this does not count towards your five required reflections).
- Send a meeting request to Mrs. Tarlo if you need help finding a mentorship or have any questions about the process.
  - o Make sure your e-mail and phone number is updated on your Profile in PathwayManager!

Next year, you will present your senior project. For those juniors who finish their mentorship early you can present in the Spring. The more you do now to prepare, the easier it will be to present. All of your clubs, activities, events, job shadows and mentorships will reflect in your presentation. Make sure you are keeping track of everything in PathwayManager as it will help you when it comes time to organize for your presentation. You can add any experience such as a speaker you heard, a career expo you attended or an experience that helped you to discover a strength about yourself into the "Points of Pride" tab in PathwayManager.
